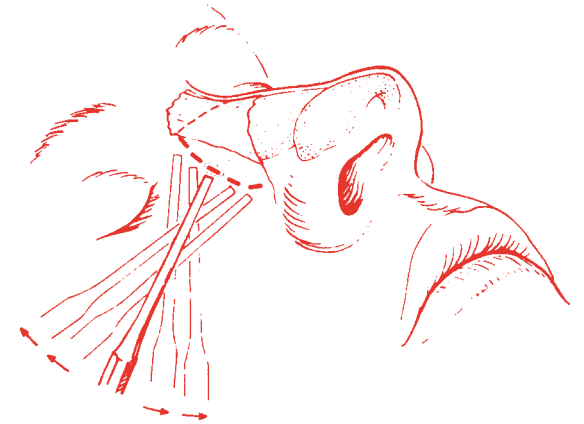

INTRODUCTION

This course aims to teach in theory and practice (cadaver dissection **with fresh frozen cadavers**) the modern rhinoplasty techniques to you on:

- osseocartilaginous vault surgery; hump resection, micro-osteotomies
- basic approaches to the nasal tip; non-delivery, delivery and external approach
- tip sculpturing
- grafts in nasal surgery; harvesting techniques, spreader grafts and composite grafts
- alar insufficiency and alar base surgery
- guidelines to rhinoplasty in children
- revision surgery
- ethnic rhinoplasty
- nasal reconstruction techniques

The teachers will emphasize coordinated and least traumatic procedures to repair both functional as well as aesthetic deformities and disorders.

It is my pleasure to introduce and welcome Prof. dr. Gilbert Nolst Trenité. He started his career in private practice for nearly 13 years in Rotterdam. After this period he became associate Professor of our department at the Academic Medical Center where he started the annual course in modern rhinoplasty techniques 16 years ago. He was former head of the Rotterdam cleft palate center. He is past-president of the European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery (EAFPS) and International federation of facial Plastic Surgery Societies (IFFPSS). He is editor of the textbook "rhinoplasty: a practical guide to functional and aesthetic surgery of the nose" and he gave many lectures and live surgery demonstrations on this topic all over the world, contributed to many text books, wrote many articles in leading international journals on aesthetic and reconstructive rhinoplasty and designed various specific rhinoplasty instruments, but above all: he is an excellent teacher.
